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POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR STRABISMUS SURGERY

- 1. Expect the eye to be red and irritated with occasional tearing. This should gradually improve over the next several weeks.
- 2. There are no restrictions on diet. The only restrictions on physical activity are to keep the eyes free of water an dirt for one week. Sponge bathing or a tub bath keeping the eye dry is recommended for the first week. Regular bathing, showering, and swimming are allowed after one week.
- 3. Call Doctor Shimokaji if you have:

Severe and persistent pain Severe and persistent discharge Loss of vision

- 4. You will be seen in the office on the day following surgery. Please call the office if you do not have an appointment.
- 5. Your postoperative medications are:

- Artificial tears, preservative-free (over the counter) drops; 1-2 drops in each eye 4-6 times a day for irritation or dryness (for as long as the irritation lasts).
